- Ensure the use of graphics, story selection, and pace are on target with action plans and style guidelines
- Communicate with information sources and producers to prepare reports for broadcast
- Communicate with reporters to find the best video stories of the day
- Write accurate and compelling teases
- Work with assignment desk to find stories, help assign reporters and make sure information is confirmed
- Work with executive producer and talent to execute daily broadcasts
- Create concise accurate writing that executes research findings
- Ensure graphics, story selection and show pace are on target with action plans and style guidelines
- Order graphics for newscasts
- Assist with live shots for booth newscasts.
- Assist in the production of special projects and other content related to program and/or station
- Perform other duties as assigned

- Ability to recognize stories with potential and develop them into compelling broadcast content
